
## Results of group work (groups 2. And 3.)

- 1. Each school will arrange an Erasmus club for students, set questions about Xenophobia, fear, bulling, social exclusion...as a central issue during lessons.
- 2. There will be an evaluation about the languages that are spoken at home (mothers, fathers, grandparents) at each school.
- 3. Each school will prepare material about the school structure/integrational tools.
- 4. Each school will bring pictures, slogans, paintings...for the art exhibition in Greece (2-4)

## Results of the musicians meeting (group 1)



#### School groups practicing for the musical



Audiovisual contents are possible to be part of the show (projection etc.).

A frame is needed.

The musical should contain 10-15 songs / numbers from about 3:30 min.

The musicals duration should be 60-75 minutes.

In the beginning the students age is about 12/13 years, when they perform they will be around 15 old.

Every school has different conditions:

La Reunion	everything there

Ideas for the story of the musical:

- different colors for each country
- at the end there might be a mixed colorful choir
- A popular person might be an outcast in other groups
- It is learned to be afraid of something

As a computer-software for arranging the music "musescore" shold be used. It is for free.



## competition:

There will be a piece of music presented for the students. The students can participate in three categories:

- 1. choreography to the music
- 2. lyrics to the music
- 3. composing other music

At the meeting in Greece every school will present their 3 best results, they have to do a pre-selection before.

The students submitting the best results are probably asked to join the meeting in greece. They can practice/ play together. This process will be filmed, in order to get material for the show.
